Addendum N° 1

TO THE FINANCING AGREEMENT FOR THE TURKEY NATIONAL PROGRAMME UNDER IPA 2008 – TRANSITION ASSISTANCE AND INSTITUTION BUILDING COMPONENT – Part 1

As originally concluded between the European Community and the Government of the Republic of Turkey on 31 March 2009

The European Community, hereinafter referred to as "the Community", represented by the Commission of the European Communities, hereinafter referred to as "the Commission",

of the one part, and

The Republic of Turkey, hereinafter referred to as "the Beneficiary",

of the other part,

jointly hereinafter referred to as the "Parties",

Whereas,

- (a) The Commission adopted on 15 December 2008 Decision C(2008)8057 establishing a National programme for Turkey under the IPA-Transition Assistance and Institution Building Component for 2008 (programme number: IPA 2008/020-213). This Programme includes 32 projects to be implemented by means of decentralised management, in the meaning of Article 53c of Council Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 1605/2002 of the Financial Regulation applicable to the general budget of the European Communities.
- (b) A Financing Agreement covering 9 of the 32 decentralised projects was concluded on 31 March 2009.
- (c) It is now necessary to add the remaining 23 projects to the Financing Agreement to cover all the decentralised projects under the National programme for Turkey.

HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

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The following provisions of the Financing Agreement for Turkey National Programme 2008, Part 1, concluded between the Parties on 31 March 2009 are modified as follows:

1 THE PROGRAMME

The Commission will contribute, by way of grant, to the financing of part I of the National Programme for Turkey under the IPA Transition Assistance and Institution Building Component for 2008 (Programme number: IPA 2008/020-213), which is set out in Annex A to this Agreement.

4 FUNDING

The funding for the implementation of this Agreement shall be as follows:

- (a) The Community contribution for The Programme is fixed at a maximum of EUR 252 195 297 (two hundred fifty two million one hundred ninety five thousand two hundred ninety seven euros). However, payments of the Community contribution by the Commission will not be made if the minimum requirements referred to in Article 41 of the IPA Implementing Regulation are not met.
- (b) The cost of the national structures and authorities indicated in Annex B shall be borne by the beneficiary country.

Article 2

All other Terms and Conditions of the original Financing Agreement Turkey National Programme 2008 Part I remain unchanged.

Article 3

This Agreement is drawn up in duplicate in the English language.

Article 4 – Entry into force

The addendum to the Financing Agreement for Turkey National Programme 2008 Part 1, shall enter into force on the date of signature. Should the parties sign on different dates, this Agreement shall enter into force on the date of signature by the second of the two Parties.
